TIPS FOR MAXIMIZING THESE RESOURCES

Start Small

- Choose 2-3 platforms that align with your industry and goals
- Attend one event per week or every other week
- Quality over quantity

Be Consistent

- Regular attendance builds relationships
- People remember faces they see repeatedly
- Consistency compounds over time

Follow Up

- Connect on LinkedIn within 48 hours
- Reference your conversation
- Offer value, not just asks

Give Before You Get

- Share resources
- Make introductions
- Offer your expertise
- Networking is reciprocal

Track Your Networking

- Keep a simple spreadsheet of events attended
 - Note connections made and follow-ups needed
 - Review monthly to see patterns and results

QUICK START ACTION PLAN

Week 1:

1. Create/update your LinkedIn profile
2. Search [Meetup.com](https://www.meetup.com) and Eventbrite for 3 events in your industry
3. Join one professional association relevant to your field

Week 2:

4. Attend your first networking event (virtual or in-person)
5. Connect with 3 people you meet on LinkedIn
6. Sign up for LinkedIn Events alerts

Week 3:

7. Attend a second event (different platform or group)
8. Follow up with connections from Week 2
9. Join an online community (Fishbowl, industry-specific forum)

Week 4:

10. Reflect on which events felt most valuable
 11. Commit to regular attendance at 1-2 groups
 12. Offer to help someone you've met
-

REMEMBER

Networking is not about collecting business cards or LinkedIn connections. It's about building genuine relationships with people who share your professional interests and values.

The best networkers:

- Show up consistently
- Listen more than they talk
- Offer help without expecting immediate returns
- Follow up and stay in touch
- Are genuinely curious about others

Your next opportunity is waiting in a conversation you haven't had yet. Start showing up!
